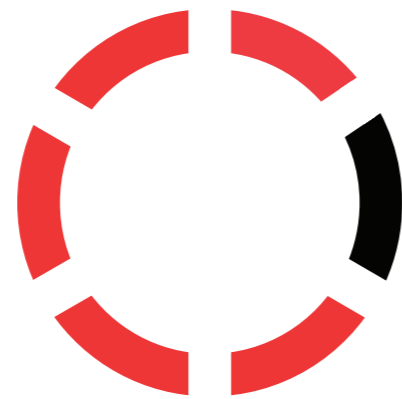
My Introduction to the Course

Interface Design



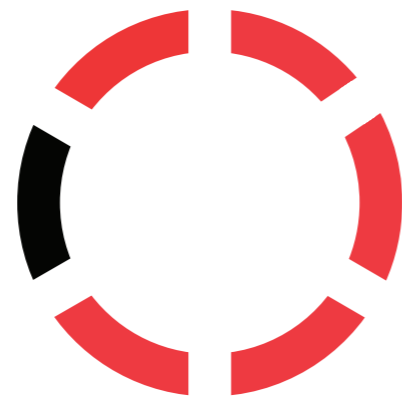
- Turned into a **personal** project
